William White was a four-year starting cornerback for Ohio State from 1984-87. He earned Academic All Big Ten Honors in 1987 and was first-team All-Big Ten and Team Captain the same year. He ranks third in career interceptions with 16. Also in 1987 he had three interceptions against West Virginia which is a tie for first place in Ohio State football history. His 11-year career in the NFL included six years with the Detroit Lions and culminated with Super Bowl XXXIII. White is Executive Vice President of CB Tech, Inc. in Columbus and Corporate Director and Franchisee of Traq3D Fitness Center.

& Buckeyeman is a proud graduate of The Ohio State University with a BS in 1967 and an MS in 1973. As a life member of the Alumni Association, he encourages all alumni to pay forward and says. "GO BUCKS!"
